It will create exemplar sustainable buildings that will be of the highest standard and sit comfortably within an attractive landscape.





To the south is Catterick Village.

The B6271 defines the southern boundary of the site and to the north a former railway line between Northallerton and Eaglescliffe.

To the east is Scorton, a small and attractive village set around a village green.

To the west of the site are sand and gravel works which have recently ceased operations.




